Private riding assessment (class RE and R) service package fee: flat rate \$1300.00; concession available

Note: drivers with neurological conditions and over the age of 70 years, require a C class OT driving assessment prior to proceeding to the R class assessment; this will cost \$2000 total (C class OT driving assessment and R class practical).

Lessons and Re-assessment:

Some clients may require a series of driving lessons and/or OT driving re-assessment. These will only be recommended where needed. These come at an additional cost, outlined as follows:

Lessons: will depend on your vehicle class - varies between \$110 - \$140/lesson

<u>Re-assessment:</u> Flat fee \$900 + riding school fee - including travel and re-assessment report to GP This will typically be required for clients following stroke, brain injury, and cognitive impairment.

Payment MUST be received 7 DAYS prior to the assessment, or the assessment will be cancelled. There is a \$30 cancellation fee for appointments cancelled within 5 days prior to the assessment. For ongoing services, any late payment or failure to pay will result in late fees and debt collection. Fee schedule is current at June 2023 and is subject to review/change.
