Lessons and Re-assessment:

Some clients may require a series of driving lessons and/or OT driving re-assessment. These will only be recommended where needed. These come at an additional cost, outlined as follows:

Lessons: will depend on your vehicle class – **varies between \$110 - \$140/lesson**

Re-assessment: **Flat fee \$1210** including riding instructor lesson fee and progress report to GP
This will typically be required for clients following stroke, brain injury, and cognitive impairment.
